

Cookie Policy

- The website Controller uses cookie files (the so-called “cookies”). In accordance with the provisions of the Telecommunications Law of 16 July 2004.
- Cookies are pieces of information sent by the website you are visiting that are stored on the end device (computer, laptop, smartphone, etc.) you use to browse the websites. Cookies contain various information such as the name of the website they come from, the time they are stored on the end device, a unique number and others. The default parameters of cookies allow the information contained in them to be read only by the server that created them.
- Cookies are used to:
 - ✚ optimise the use of the websites,
 - ✚ adjust the content of the Controller’s websites to the User’s preferences,
 - ✚ personalize websites in terms of the content displayed and to tailor advertisements.
- In many cases, the software used to browse the websites (web browser) by default allows storing cookies on the User’s end device.
- Our website allows the User to change their cookie settings individually, specifying the terms for storing or accessing cookies’ to the User’s device. The User may change the settings referred to above at any time through the settings of the software installed in the telecommunications end device used by the User or the configuration of the service. These settings can be changed especially in such a manner as to block the automatic use of cookies in the settings of the browser or to report each time cookies are placed on the User’s device. Detailed information about the possibilities and methods of using cookies are available in the settings of the software (web browser).
- You can delete cookies any time by using the functions available in the web browser you are using. Cookies do not contain any viruses or cause harm.
